INTERVIEW INFORMATION:

- <u>TUE. OCT. 19TH OR WED. OCT 20TH</u>: The interview process will be an in-person interview and will be held on Oct. 19TH OR Oct. 20th. Between 3pm and 5pm at the Depot, no appointment necessary. The actual interview will only last about 5 minutes and you are not required to stay the entire two hours. You only need to attend ONE of the in-person interviews.
- Bring this completed application/availability calendar with you when you come for your in-person interview. All
 applications will be DUE ON THE DAY OF YOUR INTERVIEW. NO EXCEPTIONS!! APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
 AFTER OCT. 20TH.
- The list of hired staff will be posted at the Depot on **Monday, Nov. 1st** and an email will be sent to those that are hired. (check your spam folder if you don't see an email from julene@hebervalleyrr.org)
- If you are hired there will be mandatory training on MONDAY, NOVEMBER 8TH, and a mandatory dress rehearsal shift NOV. 19th OR 20th.
- If you are hired you will be required to provide a copy of two forms of ID, for example, a copy of your birth certificate, Social Security card, or a passport.

Working at the Heber Valley Railroad

In order to work on the North Pole Express, you have to abide by our dress, grooming, and behavior policies. We are only interested in hiring friendly, happy, clean cut, outgoing people who like working hard, interacting with children, and adults. Most positions require you to sing, dance, serve food, clean train cars, board and deboard passengers (sometimes in cold weather). Most positions (elf, cocoa chef) require you to be "in character" while you are on the train. We have a few positions that are behind the scenes. It's a great job, but it's not for everyone. We want the great ones!
